Woodfood After-school Club and Transport

As Woodford School are no longer offering an after-school club on Fridays, we have had to review whether we are still able to provide transport to Woodford moving forwards due to rising costs.

For Mondays to Thursdays, the club should be booked through Woodford School directly on 01933 733221. If a space is available, the transport should then be booked through ParentPay. However, they currently have a waiting list, therefore unless you already have a regular booking, it is unlikely that you will be able to secure a space at short notice.

In the meantime, we can continue to offer transport to Woodford on Fridays until the Easter holidays, for the children that live in the village only.

From week commencing 15th April, we will only be able to continue to offer transport on Fridays should it be able to cover its own costs. Therefore, all children regardless of where they live, that use the transport, must book the minibus through ParentPay at a cost of £1.00 per day.

Please can you confirm by email whether you will use the transport on Fridays after Easter by the deadline of **15**th **March**, so we are able to decide on whether we can continue to offer this service on Fridays. Thank you for your patience and support with this.


World Book Day - Thursday 7th March
