Developing our exploration skills in Deene

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

At school we will be:

- *Continuing to develop our awareness of feelings, and ways to be kind and considerate to others.
- *Showing pride in ourselves, our work and our achievements.

At home you could:

*Play turn taking games and talk about sharing.



Physical Development

At school we will be:

- *Continuing to develop our small motor skills so that we can use a range of tools confidently, competently and safely.
- * Developing our overall balance, co-ordination and agility.
- * Continuing to explore how leading a healthy lifestyle and healthy eating contributes to good health.

At home you could:

*Talk about keeping healthy and how exercise is good for our bodies. Encourage your child to try new foods, brush their teeth twice a day and have a good bedtime routine.



Communication and Language At school we will be:

*Listening attentively in a range of situations, including carpet times, group times and assemblies, considering the speaker and listener, taking turns to speak in different situations.

*Making predictions in stories and linking to own experiences.

* At home you could:

- *Share stories from home, visit the library. Discuss the setting/ characters in the story and make predictions about what might happen next.
- *Encourage me to use the correct tense when re-telling stories
- *Help me to respond sensitively to social situations, using good manners.

Literacy

At school we will be:

- *Using our phonic knowledge to read and write words.
- *Forming simple sentences.
- *Reading and writing our POWER words with accuracy.
- *Beginning to form most letters correctly.
- *Looking at fiction, non-fiction and poetry

At home you could:

- *Practise forming letters correctly.
- *Share my reading book at home and review sound cards and tricky words.

Understanding the World:

At school we will be:

- *Develop our curiosity and interest in finding out about people in our community and other countries, special places, events and objects.
- *Developing our enquiring skills by finding out about different locations and places, describing features and looking at similarities and differences. Through stories and celebrations such as the Chinese New Year.
- *Developing our mapping skills, recognising how environments are different to where we live. E.g Antartica/Space.

At home you could:

*Explore and discuss places around the world you have been to or would like to visit. Where are they? How would you get there? Discuss the similarities and differences to where we live



Characteristics of Effective Learning At school we will be:

- *Showing satisfaction in meeting own goals and enjoying meeting
- enjoying meeting challenges.
- *Using imagination in roleplay.
- *Making predictions and reviewing how well things went.

At home you could:

*Encourage me to plan tasks and discuss them

Mathematics

At school we will be:

- *Counting objects, and actions. Counting by rote and using actions and objects to represent numbers and subitise.
- *Comparing numbers, recognising what is 'more than' and 'fewer than'.
- *Exploring the composition of numbers, knowing that a numbers are made up of smaller numbers.
- *Exploring and comparing mass, capacity, length and time.

At home you could:

*Explore maths within your environment and the natural world. How many can you see, what do you see? How do you know? Is there more/fewer?

Expressive Arts and Design

At school we will be:

- *Planning, designing and constructing with a purpose in mind, returning to creations and building upon previous learning and refining ideas.
- *Developing our imaginations through stories, dance, role-play, small world and construction play.
- *Exploring the artist, Van Gough

At home you could:

*Develop imaginations through storytelling with toys and when building models using a range of materials.
