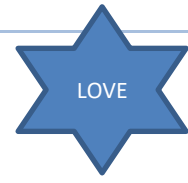

As we are now officially into the last month of the school year, the pressure really is on to fit everything into the time we have left – phew....!!

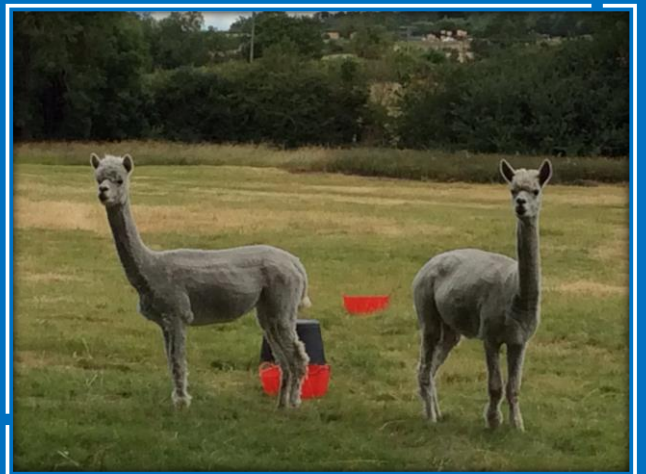
