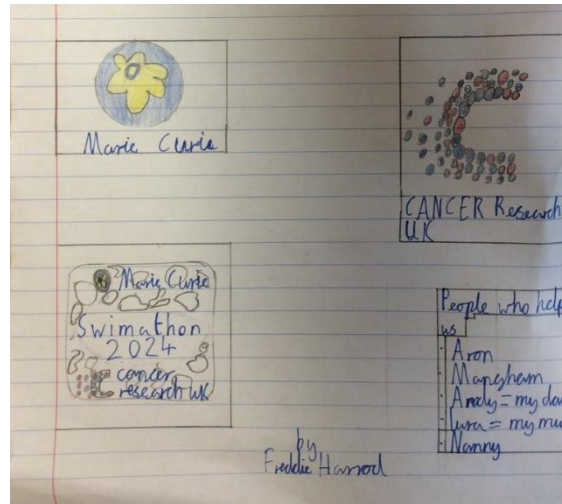

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

The Year 1 Phonics Screening Check takes place in the **week beginning 10th June**. Year 2 non-statutory assessments

Although End Of Key Stage 1 Assessments are no longer mandatory, schools are encouraged to use them to inform their teacher assessments. This year's assessments will be completed following the May Half-Term.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

This check is a short, online assessment which takes no longer than 5 minutes to complete. Its purpose is to assess whether pupils can fluently recall their times tables up to 12. The outcomes of the assessment will be shared with you in end of Summer Term reports.

This check will take place in school during a **2 week window from Monday 3rd June**. You can find out more about it in the information guide - see the link below.
